DISCUSSION: MARC LOPES DISCUSSED THE INCREASE OF STUDENTS SUSPENDED FOR USING DRUGS AND ALCOHOL. THE GOAL IS TO CREATE AN INDEPENDENT CONTRACT WITH DAVID KAKOOLA TO PROVIDE INDIVIDUAL AND SMALL GROUP COUNSELING FOR STUDENTS WHO ARE SUSPENDED FOR DRUGS AND ALCOHOL; AND ALLOW STUDENTS TO VOLUNTEER ATTEND COUNSELING.

CONCLUSION: DAVID KAKOOLA WILL BE HIRED TO PROVIDE INDIVIDUAL AND SMALL GROUP COUNSELING FOR STUDENTS. DAVID WILL WORK FOUR HOURS DURING 1 DAY PER WEEK. DAVID WILL BE PAID \$500 PER DAY FOR APPROXIMATELY 10 DAYS. THEREFORE, TITLE 1 FUNDS WILL BE USED TO HELP STUDENTS WHO ARE STRUGGLING TO ACCESS THEIR EDUCATION BECAUSE OF ADDICTION ISSUES.
